## Attendance

Our highest class attendance last week was 90.87% for Class 5. This is extremely low and our whole school attendance was 88.84%. This is really concerning and research shows that anything below 89% has a **drastic** effect on academic achievement. Figures between 95 to 90% are a serious cause for concern. May we ask that you strive to get your children to school as much as possible.
