Implementation of a RE Lesson at Saint Charles



What would we expect to see in a RE lesson in our school?

- Children working on objectives in line with the Nottingham Diocese Come and See scheme of work.
- Lessons are based on the long term plan and are within a sequence, following the learning foci.
- Lessons are based on the child's ability level following regular assessments that are planned by the Nottingham Catholic Education Service.
- All teachers will start the lesson by lighting a candle and saying a prayer.
- Topics start with pre-unit assessment and big question and all topics end with a postunit assessment.
- All lessons include Scripture.
- Learning Objective proforms include the learning focus (LF), Scripture and task for the lesson.
- Religious Education will then be taught using Scripture readings, PowerPoints and videos.
- Tasks to showcase learning take various forms, for example: diary entries, letter writing, art, drama and prayer writing.
- Within all units, there will be opportunity for children to: write at length, to 'wonder' through a wonder cloud question and share their feelings through a 'heart' response.

An outline of a St Charles RE lesson

- 1. Candle is lit, sign of the cross is made and a prayer is said. (candle stays lit for the whole lesson).
- 2. Whole Class Feedback is shared with the children from the previous lesson's learning.
- 3. This lesson's learning focus is shared with the children.
- 4. Scripture is read to the children.
- 5. Learning activities take place.
- 6. Children are given opportunity to wonder and reflect on their feelings through a heart or cloud post-it note activity.
- 7. Lesson ends with the sign of the cross.
