

Enrichment and Ethos

The curriculum promotes long-term learning with an emphasis on 'knowing more and remembering more'. We recognise that knowledge is 'sticky' and that the more pupils know, the easier it becomes for them to learn more. Regular revisiting of prior learning is embedded in each lesson through 'flashback' activities and by making explicit links between current and previous learning. In this way, we aim to build rich webs of knowledge as children progress.

Through our planned activities, children have opportunities to be creative, physically active and academically challenged. Our curriculum is further enriched by our strong ethos based on Catholic Social Teaching, with Christ at the centre of all that we do.
